It could analyze and review a particular topic, address gaps, issues, or challenges in the body of knowledge, and enable and encourage dialogue and create new ideas.

	- Summary and importance of the issue, including the topic and scope (with a broad interest within the scope
	of the journal). Please provide the nature of the special issue: State-of-the-art review, special topics focusing
	on new insights and future directions, guest edited by prominent researcher(s), historical perspective, or
	industry focus.
	– Target audience. Please be specific.
	- If you will be inviting authors, please also include a list of potential contributors with their emails/websites
	- Estimated timeline of when you plan to solicit papers and expect authors will be ready to submit papers
	- If the special issue will be based on a conference, also include the conference name, location, and dates
	 ASTM will confirm receipt of your materials and may ask for follow-up questions; we will confirm with you when the special issue has been approved

	to those sites are for regular issues only and will not be included in your special issue
4	• If you have more than one guest editor, please inform the peer review team which guest editor will receive all correspondence
	for each manuscript; only one guest editor can be assigned per manuscript
	• You will serve as an editorial board member for all papers (except any for which you are a coauthor); in this role, you will select at least 2 reviewers for each paper, read the reviews, and recommend action (accept, revise, or reject)
	 The ASTM Committee on Publications requires 2 independent reviews for all papers. As a guest editor, you may not be a
	reviewer. If the 2 reviews greatly conflict, you may seek a third review. If you feel you have a situation that requires more
	than 3 reviewers, please contact Alyssa or the peer review team (astm@jjeditorial.com)
	• After a paper receives the required number of reviews (2–3), it will be sent to you to make your recommendation
	• When revised papers are submitted, you may immediately make a recommendation (accept, revise, or reject), or you may
	send the revision back to one or more of the original reviewers. Please do not add new reviewers for revised papers
	For each paper, the final decision will be made by the Journal Editor

5	• As papers are accepted, they will be exported to the J& Production team for copyediting, typesetting, and author proofing
	• Papers that clear peer review and production before the scheduled special issue publication date may publish online on the

- Abstract of the research articles for the Special Issue SUBMITTAL

A 250-word preliminary abstract should be submitted to ASTM (attention to Alyssa Conaway) by the *abstract due date* via email to Alyssa Conaway at <u>aconaway@astm.org</u>. The abstract must include a clear definition of the objective and approach of the work to be discussed, pointing out new material, and present sufficient details regarding results. It should be clearly indicated in the abstract if the paper is a review. The abstract must also include a title and the names and affiliations of all Author(s).

PUBLICATION

After the final selection of abstracts has been approved, the ASTM Editorial Office will invite authors to submit papers no later than <u>due date for the manuscript</u>. All submissions will be uploaded to the special issue paper submission site (link to be sent via email). All submissions will be peer-reviewed according to the normal procedures for this journal. The papers must not be of a commercial nature nor can they have been previously published, although reviews of previously published technology will be considered.

Videos

When uploading the full papers to the submission site, authors can also submit an appropriate video to accompany their paper. The video should be uploaded as a "supplemental file for review" in the file upload section. If you are submitting a video, <u>contact Alyssa Conaway for details</u>.

All authors for whom we receive a valid email address will be able to download a copy of their paper in portable document format (PDF). All authors will have the opportunity to purchase reprints of their papers at a nominal cost. The papers comprising the special issue will be published together online.
